



Transition to Work

Transition to Work supports young people aged 15–21 on their journey to finding a job. MTC Australia provides personalised support to each participant, helping them to unlock their potential, transition to employment or further study, and start building the life they want.

As part of this program, we maintain strong links with local employers, service providers, schools and other education providers so we can support their needs.

We help employers find young employees, and provide support for at least the first six months of employment to ensure a smooth transition. We can also:

- Provide pre-employment training to young people to help them build skills that are directly relevant to employer needs
- Arrange work experience placements for eligible participants to assess a young person's suitability for a job
- Negotiate wage subsidies for employers

For early school leavers aged 15-21, Transition to Work offers one-on-one support with a dedicated youth coach to help support them on the journey to finding a job.

Who is it For?

Transition to Work is designed for young people who are finding it hard to secure a job after school. To be eligible, they need to be:

- Aged 15–21
- An Australian citizen or hold a permanent visa, a New Zealand Special Category Visa or a Nominated Visa (including Temporary Protection Visa or Safe Haven Visa)

Eligibility also depends on a young person's circumstances, including whether the young person:

- Has been awarded a Year 12 certificate or Certificate III
- Has been employed within the last six months
- Receives an income support payment such as Youth Allowance
- Is currently participating in another employment service including jobactive

MTC Australia's Transition to Work is open to all employers, education providers and service providers in Parramatta, Auburn and Merrylands and surrounding areas.

Once an employee has started their new job or study, we provide support for at least the first six months to help them settle in.

We can help employers understand and access funding, services and networks for which they may be eligible.
