The Skills for Education & Employment (SEE) program provides you with a pathway to further education or employment. You'll improve your skills in English language, literacy and numeracy. The SEE program also includes basic computer literacy skills. SEE is all about YOU: you choose your goals and we support you to achieve them in a way that suits you.

Who is it For?

To be eligible for SEE, you need to be:

- Aged 15-64
- Registered as a jobseeker with Centrelink or a jobactive provider
- An Australian citizen, permanent resident or have working rights in Australia

If you're registered with Centrelink, you can learn English and become job-ready through our SEE program. Up to 650 hours of FREE training, with flexible hours and locations.

How it Works

SEE is a government-funded program, which means it's FREE. You can get up to 650 hours of training at one of our 15 sites across Sydney. The hours are flexible so you can fit them around your other commitments. At the end of the program, you may be eligible to receive one of the following qualifications:
