Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) is a government-funded program that will improve your English language, computer and job searching skills. Eligible students receive up to 650 hours of classes for free, and may enrol at any time of the year. Come and learn in a welcoming environment where you can be yourself, make new friends and achieve your goals.

IS SEE FOR YOU?

To be eligible for SEE, you need to be:

- Aged 15–64
- Registered as a job seeker with Centrelink or a jobactive provider
- An Australian citizen, permanent resident or have working rights in Australia

ABOUT SEE

SEE is government-funded and no cost to students. You can choose to study full-time or part-time, morning or afternoon, so you can fit classes around your other commitments. Choose where you study too: MTC offers SEE at 15 different Sydney locations. At the end of the program, you may be eligible to receive one of the following qualifications:
